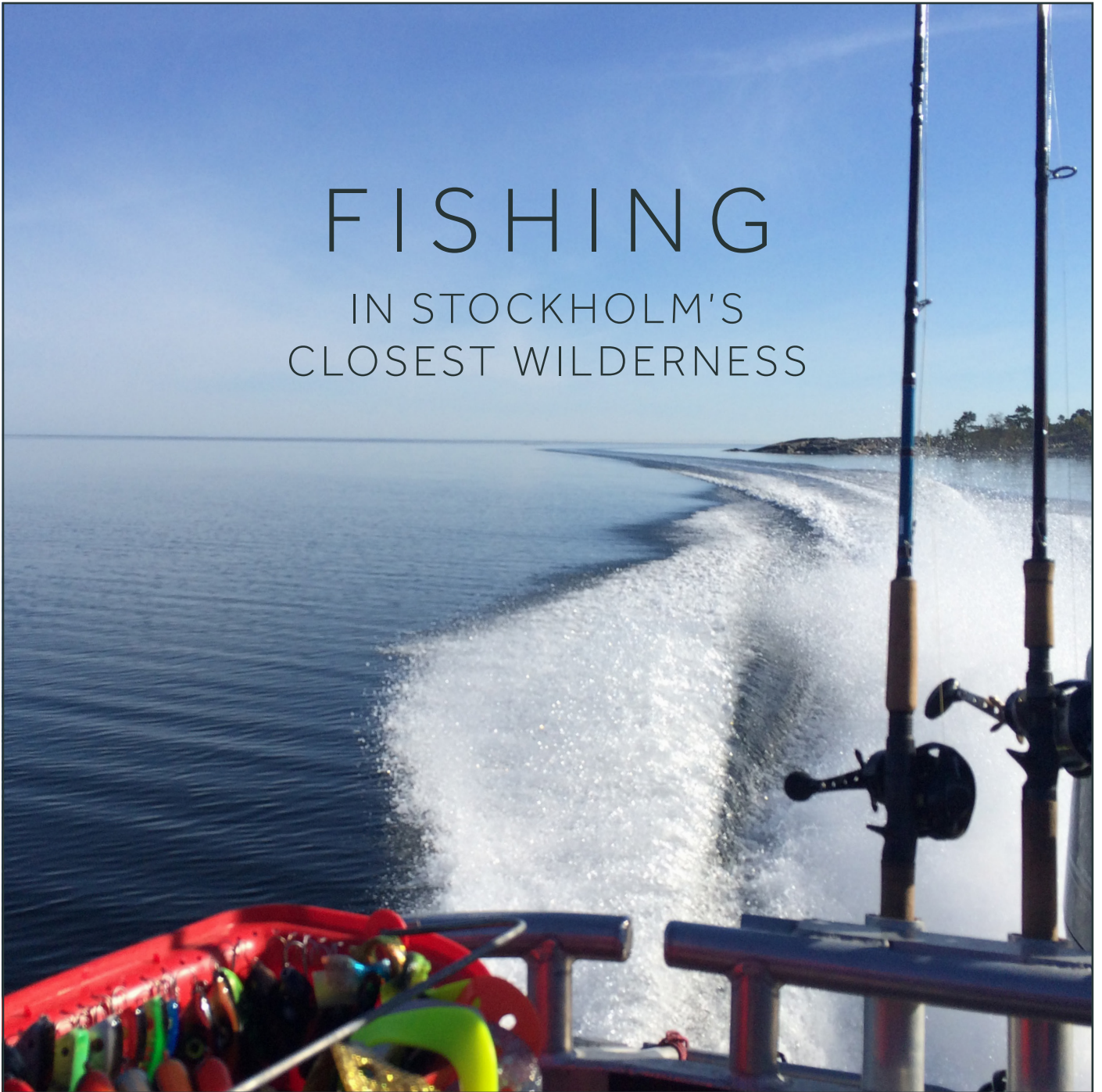


FISHING

AN ADVENTURE IN THE OUTER OF STOCKHOLM ARCHIPELAGO

Come have an adventure in Stockholm's closest wilderness among thousands of untouched skerries and islands! Let our fishing guides show you the breath-taking nature furthest out in the Stockholm Archipelago. Enjoy two entire days at sea, delicious local food and comfortable accommodation. All in a globally unique environment.

The guides from Sjö & Havsguiderna will take you to the hot spots for fishing far away from the typical tourist areas, maybe you will even catch the fish of your dreams. You will cook your lunches over an open fire on a Muurika, a traditional Swedish outdoor griddle pan, and enjoy the peace and quiet.

Season: April-May and Sep-Oct

Duration: 2 nights and 2 days

Group size: 4pers / boat. Min 4 pers



DAY BY DAY

First day

Your first stay on this adventure is at the hotel Åtellet located in the harbor of Norrtälje with the Baltic sea just outside the window.

Take the opportunity to explore Norrtälje with its fascinating history from the early 1700's. Back at the hotel, a three-course dinner made from local produce is served. After a good night's sleep at Åtellet, you will be ready for a day of fishing among beautiful island and skerries.

Second day

Day two starts off with a delicious breakfast to give you lots energy – perfect for a whole day out on the water.

Sjö & Havsguiderna will pick you up at the waterfront outside Åtellet for a day of fishing, lots of fresh air and nature adventuring. Out in the wilderness, it is easy to find a good place for a typical Swedish "fika" (coffee break) – the hard part is to pick the best one. Fortunately, you have the best guides in these parts of the archipelago at your disposal, and they know the best places for a Muurikka lunch and a coffee break.



DAY BY DAY

In the afternoon you will end up on the island Arholma, far out on the archipelago coastline.

Here you will stay at Arholma Nord, an old military facility from the Cold War which is now both a hostel and a restaurant. A warm sauna, good food and comfortable beds are keys to a lovely evening and a great way to sum up your experiences and get ready for a new day at sea. At Arholma, you also have time to explore the island and its history. The easiest way to do this is by bike, which you can borrow from Arholma Nord. There will be a guide present at Arholma during your stay.

Third day

After a good night's sleep, you will be served breakfast with a wonderful view of the horizon.

Sjö & havsguiderna will pick you up after breakfast and you will fish your way back to Norrtälje.

When evening is arriving you will tie down the boat in Norrtälje harbour. Here you can choose to continue your adventure in Stockholm or add one more night at our friends out in the archipelago.
